

## Check-list: Important documents to bring to Frankfurt for EU citizens:

- 1. A passport or equivalent identification document.
- 2. Certified copies in German or English of your **secondary school leaving certificates** (High School Diploma,GCE, Baccalaureate etc.), of your **university degrees** and, where applicable, of your **doctoral degree** (if employment at GU is intended).
- 3. **Certificate of good conduct** (applicable only for long term employment contracts with GU civil service)
- 4. Your marriage certificate and your children's birth certificates if your wife and/or your children are accompanying you. If possible, these documents should be translated into German.
- 5. Confirmation of your **health insurance coverage**, if your coverage is also valid for your visit to Germany (for short term stays: European Health Insurance Card EHIC).
- 6. If you have **personal liability or private accident insurance** in your home country, you should find out whether the coverage is also valid in Germany. If so, please bring the appropriate documents with you.
- 7. If applicable, a **statement regarding any current or previous illnesses** (also any recent X-rays) as well as any medication you are taking at the time of your departure
- 8. An **international "green" insurance card** to confirm that you have automobile liability insurance that is valid in Germany (if you plan to bring your own car to Germany).
- 9. Confirmation from your automobile liability insurance provider that you have an accident-free **driving record**. This will enable you to obtain a lower insurance premium if you intend to take out liability insurance while in Germany.
