**Responsibilities:**

The tasks of the researcher will consist primarily of teaching in Sociology for Bachelor and Master students, including educational sciences and teaching studies. The main focus should be on quantitative analyses of social change in Germany or in comparative perspective. Teaching on quantitative methods and one of the following areas, quantitative content analysis, social inequality or family sociology, is required. The candidate will have to teach 4 university hours (each 45 minutes) per week, corresponding to two courses.

Opportunities for self-directed research, in particular for further qualification, and participation in ongoing research projects will be provided.

**Requirements:**

The candidate should hold a PhD degree in the Social Sciences, have excellent knowledge of the above work areas and excellent skills in the application of advanced quantitative methods in Stata and SPSS (R would be an asset), shown in national and international peer reviewed publications.
