The European Forum Alpbach is an interdisciplinary platform for science, politics, business and culture. Every year, 700 students from about 90 nationalities participate in the European Forum Alpbach. Join smart minds from around the world in a charming Alpine village, immersing yourself in an environment bursting with novel ideas, new ways of thinking and opportunities for making great contacts.

The European Forum Alpbach 2022 will be centered on the following four thematic tracks: **Securing Europe's Future in a Globalized World; The Climate Opportunity; The Financing of Europe's Future and The Future of Democracy and the Rule of Law in Europe.**

For the six time the Goethe University sponsors ten scholarships for the attendance at the European Forum Alpbach 2022.¹ The scholarship covers the participation fee as well as expenses for accommodation and subsistence and a travel allowance. Accommodation will be provided in simple housing and shared rooms.

Who can apply?

- Students and Doctoral Candidates from Goethe University from all academic disciplines up to the age of 30.
- **International students are highly encouraged to apply.**

What do we expect?

- Interest in the general topic of the European Alpbach Forum
- Very good English Skills (minimum B2-Level)
- An open, critical and tolerant mindset, that is open for new perspectives
- Active participation at the seminars, lectures and workshops at the European Forum Alpbach
- Attendance at the program before and after the European Forum Alpbach organized by the Goethe University

Next to a completed application form, you will have to upload the following documents/proofs:

- Curriculum Vitae (max. 1 page)
Note: CV should display your education, practical experience and extra-curricular activities
- Motivational Statement in English
Note: The Motivational Statement should reflect your thoughts and ideas on one of the thematic tracks mentioned above. Further, it should include your perspective on European Integration as well as your view on the values of the European Forum Alpbach.
- Transcript of Records or Bachelor-/Master Degree certificate
- Evidence of your English proficiency (minimum B2-level) for non-native speakers
Note: Evidence that you have reached European level B2, e.g. a confirmation by your school, employer or a university professor, explicitly stating that you have reached B2 or an equivalent to B2. If the document fails to prove that you have reached B2, we will not be able to consider it. We also accept language certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS

When to apply?

- Applications can be sent in from **29. April – 20. Mai 2022** via the digital scholarship application tool: <https://tinygu.de/StipendiumAlpbach>
- Letters of acceptance and refusal will be sent out by the end of July 2022
