Visit to Senckenberg Museum

The Naturmuseum Senckenberg is Frankfurt's outstanding museum of natural history, the second-largest in Germany. Collaborating closely with GU, the museum is owned and operated by the Senckenberg Nature Research Society. The Museum boasts a large collection of animal exhibits from every epoch of Earth's history. Big public attractions include the Tyrannosaurus rex, an original of an Iguanodon and the Triceratops. Unique in Europe is a cast of the famous Lucy, an almost complete skeleton of the upright hominid Australopithecus afarensis.
