Why is a stay abroad important during your studies?

Professional competence

At a foreign partner university, study content can be examined from a different academic perspective. This enables students to broaden their professional horizons.

Language skills

Abroad, both your studies and everyday life usually have to be mastered in a different language. Students learn new languages or consolidate existing language skills.

Intercultural competence

Students experience a change of perspective abroad. You will work in an international environment and get to know the culture, politics, and society of your host country.

ERASMUS+


- More than 80 Erasmus+ partner universities in 21 countries
- Waiver of tuition fees at the partner university, mobility grant, recognition of academic achievements
- Ideal times are the third to fifth semester in a bachelor's programme and the third semester in a master's programme.
- Application: Erasmus+ places are announced each year in November. The application deadline is
 1 February of each year and applies for the whole academic year, i.e. the winter semester of the current year and the summer semester of the following year.
