Dear colleagues,

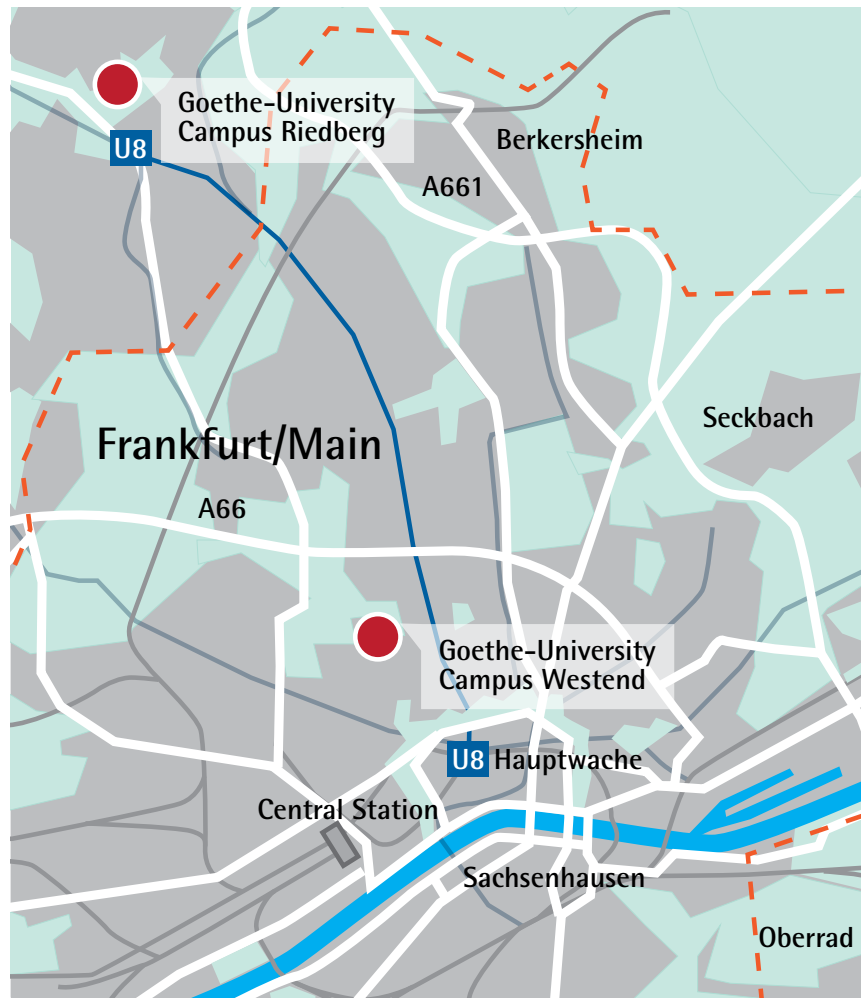
